Your practice is participating in an ICB-led countywide Prescribing and Medicines Optimisation Scheme (PMOS) penicillin allergy de-labelling (PADL) initiative in primary care, looking at patients who have an 'allergy to penicillin' label in their health record but who have since been prescribed penicillin.
