RE: Invitation to take part in a research study - Views and experiences Of primary Care penicillin allergy de-labelling (ALABAMA-VOICE)

Our records show you have taken part in a consultation with a health care professional from your GP practice, most likely a pharmacist or GP, to talk about removing the penicillin allergy label from your medical notes.

Researchers from the Universities of Leeds and Oxford would like to invite you to take part in the ALABAMA-VOICE study. The study is funded by the University of Leeds who are working with NHS colleagues in Cornwall.
